- Size: 1.6 (40mm) inches long use DMC Embroidery floss and size 0.6 mm

Crochet Hook

- Size: 3 (75mm) inches long use cotton thread size 10 and 1.0mm crochet hook
- Needle and Thread
- 2 small black beads or stitch the eyes with French knots
- stuffing
- small tweezers for stuffing

- Ch: chain
- St: stitch
- Sc: single crochet
- Slst: Slip stitch

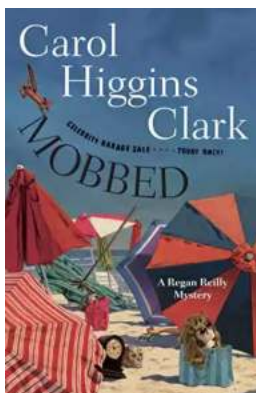

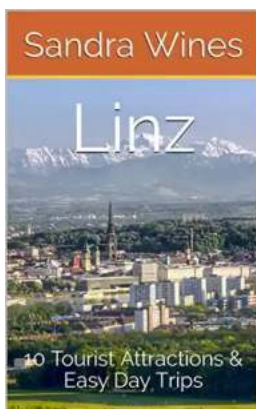

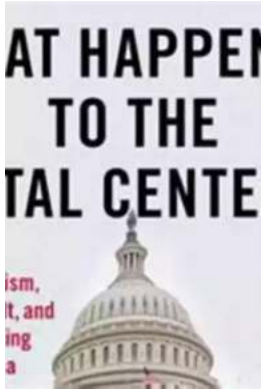
